Unit 4: How Do I Live My Life?

- Ultimate lesson: The Lord's prayer teaches us to daily receive God's gifts and commend our lives to Him.
- What is Prayer?
 - o Talking to God in words and thoughts.
 - o "Jesus never taught His disciples how to preach; only how to pray."
- Ways to pray (p98-99 in journal)
 - o A-C-T-S
 - o "Simple Way to Pray"
 - o Circle Out
 - o Spontaneous, Biblical, Written, from memory
 - o Don't be afraid to Google
 - o Prayer takes practice—it's okay if you're just starting!
- Walked through the Lords' Prayer
 - o Our Father, who art in heaven
 - The word is *Abba*, like Papa.
 - So we pray, "Heavenly Father..."
 - o Hallowed be Thy name.
 - He desires us to keep His name holy, not make it holy.
 - So we pray, "Most Holy God..."
 - Thy kingdom come
 - Three ways to think of the kingdom:
 - Power (all of creation)
 - Grace (where His Word is spread or heard)
 - Glory (still coming with Jesus)
 - So we pray, "Bringer of the Kingdom..."
 - o Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven
 - God's will is that all people come to know Him as their Father and live under the reign and rule of His Son.
 - How do we know God's will?
 - What does the Bible have to say about it?
 - What's the wisdom of mature Christians I trust?
 - What is the Spirit telling me through circumstances?
 - Have I prayed over it?
 - So we pray, "To the One who knows better than I do..."
 - o Give us this day our daily bread
 - Teaches us to be thankful, content, and thoughtful
 - So we pray, "Provider of all that I need..."
 - And forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us
 - Because of what Jesus did we pray this with honesty, humility, and confidence
 - We forgive like God does: immediately, fully, freely, and frequently
 - So we pray, "Merciful and forgiving Father..."
 - Lead us not into temptation
 - The doors are always opening—no temptation to great for God
 - So we pray, "My leader and protector..."
 - But deliver us from evil
 - We live without fear. Satan has no weapon we can't call out.
 - So we pray, "Great deliverer..."
